## It's Getting Fishy! Tim Jenson - Saskatoon



We have talked about stocking the dugout in the yard with Fish for years; this year we were given the green light! Keet's Fish Farm in Asquith gave me all the



info we needed. I measured our dugout to approximately 450 feet long and 250 feet wide - I also measured the depth with my fish finder to be approx. 30 feet deep.

In May Kurt Flaman and I went to pick up 600 Rainbow Trout which were put into 18 big bags of water. Many employees came out to the dugout to help as we had to put the bag of fish into the water for 20 minutes to adjust the temperature of the water in the bags then we opened the bags and let the fish out. We were all excited to see them being released and all took turns opening bags. We took handfuls of fish food and threw it into the water and were able to see some of the fish jumping.

The fish were 6 inches long when we put them in and by September they should be 10-12 inches long and weigh between 1 and 1 ½ lbs. It will be great place to bring the kids on a Sunday afternoon to fish and maybe cook some hotdogs.

I am excited to be able to do this. It should last for a few years and we plan on stocking more next year!
